50th Annual Property Careers Fair

On behalf of the Cambridge University Land Society, I am writing to let you know that the annual Property Careers Fair will be held on Tuesday 28th October. The Careers Fair provides a great opportunity to promote internship, graduate and post-graduate positions at your company to current students. This will be the 50th year that the Land Society has hosted the event and it would be fantastic if you, or representatives of your company, are able to join us.

As you may be aware, the undergraduate Land Economy degree is unique; it not only provides graduates with the relevant exemptions to immediately qualify to join the RICS APC programme, but it also provides them with a much wider perspective by covering law, investment and finance, urban and environmental economics, town planning, resource management and sustainability. In addition the Department of Land Economy also offers three post-graduate degrees; Real Estate Finance, Planning, Growth and Regeneration, and Land Economy Research. Last year, the event attracted around 150 students; predominately land economists but also those studying Maths, Geography, Management, Economics, Engineering and Law. This year, in association with the CULS Architecture, Planning, Engineering and Construction Forum, we are also working with the Department of Architecture to promote the event directly to their students for the first time.

We welcome all employers offering opportunities in property and the environment. For example, we typically have representatives from agency, property finance, law, management consultancy, investment, development and asset management. Alongside our regular recruiters, we are particularly keen to encourage architectural practices, smaller firms and those with global opportunities to also attend.

The Careers Fair will be hosted at the Guildhall, just off Market Square in the centre of Cambridge, between 4–7pm. Where alumni are able to act as representatives, we do find this beneficial in terms of creating a connection with current students. The format of the event is informal discussions around employers' stands until 6pm, followed by drinks and networking until 7pm to celebrate the 50th anniversary. There is no fixed charge for attending. However, if your company is able, we would be very grateful for donations towards the cost of promoting and hosting the event.
